Chan. Additionally, I would like to communicate to you other activities of the Board and the Committees, as well as some really important information as we approach the 21st IAPD Congress in Hong-Kong.

Revision of Constitution

The Board in its meeting in Amsterdam in 2006, decided that revision and refinement of the entire Constitution was long overdue. The Constitution Review Committee has worked arduously and completed the revision of the Constitution, the By Laws and the Standing Orders of our Association. These documents have been sent to the Board for their comments and input. As required by the Constitution 90 days prior to the next Council Meeting (early March) the above documents will be sent to the IAPD National Member Societies for their input and consideration. Comments should be sent to the Secretary General about the end of April, 40 days prior to the Council Meeting.

National & individual membership

In order for a National Member Society to participate in the next Council Meeting and also to maintain it's membership, their dues should be remitted for this year as soon as possible. If the dues statements have not yet reached your National Society please contact our Association's Coordinator Mrs Sylvie Dutilloy (iapd@fdiworldental.org). It may be a case of a postal problem or incorrect address. The strength of our Association is very much dependent on individual members. By increasing the number of both national and individual members we will make our Association really international. Our strength globally depends on the size of our membership! A special category of individual membership is the postgraduate student membership. We consider postgraduate students the future and the hope for the continuation of IAPD. 
National Member Societies: Delegates

Message from the IAPD Editor



International Journal of Paediatric Dentistry (IJPD)

The top Paediatric Dentistry Journal

Under the dynamic leadership of the Editor, Professor Göran Dahllöf, our journal has during recent years developed tremendously and is now to be looked upon as one of the leading pae-

diatric dentistry journals in the world. We really have to be proud of our Journal.

The International Journal of Paediatric Dentistry (IJPD) was formed in 1991 by the merger of the Journals of the International Association of Paediatric Dentistry and the British Society of Paediatric Dentistry. The Journal is published bi-monthly in print and online (accessible via http://www.blackwell-synergy.com/loi/ipd). And, Dear Member, the subscription of the Journal is included in your membership fee.

The IJPD aims to promote the highest standard of education, clinical practice and research in paediatric dentistry world-wide. This includes all aspects of paediatric dentistry: preventive, restorative and orthodontic treatment for children, behavioural management, and aspects of community dentistry related to children.

The Journal has a wide reach of readers. In 2006 the Journal was distributed in print and/or online to almost 5,000 institutions worldwide, including paying subscribers. In addition more than 1,500 people receive the journal through a personal subscription.

The great interest in the *International Journal of Pae-diatric Dentistry* is also recorded in downloads of individual articles published in the Journal. In 2006, the *International Journal of Paediatric Dentistry* published

84 articles and the total downloads were 85,932 times. This compares to 72,399 downloads in 2005, and in fact there has been a steady increase in downloads over the last couple of years.

The International Journal of Paediatric Dentistry aims to be the primary forum for the publication of scientific articles in paediatric dentistry. One of the key aspects in securing that the Journal attracts the best high quality research is for the Journal to have an Impact Factor. Thus we are happy to inform that the Journal has recently been accepted by the Institute for Scientific Information, and it will now be indexed in Current Contents/ Clinical Medicine, Science Citation Index Expanded/ SciSearch and Journal Citation Reports. This means that the journal will receive its first impact factor in 2009 based on its publication in 2006 and 2007.

In October 2005. The International Journal of Paediatric Dentistry introduced online manuscript submission and peer-review on the following platform: mc.manuscriptcentral.com/ijpd. The advantages of the online submission and reviewing system are many. The foremost advantage is that the online system is available worldwide for authors and reviewers 24/7 (that is, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week), and that this system proves time saving as everything including correspondence is now handled online. The result for International Journal of Paediatric Dentistry has been a faster peer review process and an increase in submissions. In 2006 the Journal received a record of 284 manuscripts and the current time from submission to first decision is now only 38 days.

South African Paedodontic Society

From the 25th October to 2nd November 2006 I visited South Africa as a guest speaker of the Paedodontic Society of South Africa. During this time 4 highly successful congresses were held in the 4 major cities of South Africa: Durban, Johannesburg, Cape Town and Bloemfontein.

The K.Z. Natal Branch of the South African Dental Association (SADA) ran a Paedodontic and Prosthodontic Congress on the 27th—28th October in Durban.

The Johannesburg congress was held on the 29th October 2006. The feedback from the dentists who attended was very positive, and will probably contribute to the increase of awareness of Pediatric Dentistry among the

general dentists. On the 1st November, the University of Western Cape hosted me as part of a one day 'Refresher Course in Paediatric Dentistry'. Finally, on the 2nd November, the OFS branch of SADA ran a mini congress in Bloemfontein, with dentists attending from all over the Free State.

The audience was very receptive and the members were very pleased to accept Dr. Lopez's proposal for the Ecua-



dorian Society to apply and become a Society Member of IAPD.
