#### **POSTER PRESENTATION:**

The presenting author must be present at the time defined for their presentation and willing to answer questions from the audience and evaluators.

# **EVALUATION COMMITTEE:**


The scientific committee designated two chairpersons per session, one national professor and one international professor.

# SOCIAL PROGRAMME

#### **OPENING CEREMONY:**

The activity was held in the Great Hall of the Sheraton Hotel Santiago, along with the presence of more than 1000 participants.

In this version, the organizers confirmed the participation of more than 1,000 attendees from around the world, more than 40 exhibitors from the pediatric dentistry industry and more than 60 international speakers, who will present different clinical cases and medical researches during the four days of the event.

In addition, during the activity a video was presented that showed the most representative places of Chile, with close-ups of children smiling as a symbol of the slogan" Southern View for Children's Smiles ", as expressed by their authors, who also remembered Dr. Daniel Rollet.

After this ceremony, the public was invited to a Welcome Cocktail where they shared and talked about this first day.

The Organizing Committee decided to use the Facebook LIVE platform. The motive? "We know that many colleagues could not come to Chile for personal reasons, so we decided to open a window to the world and share with everyone this wonderful moment thanks to the advanced technology that we implement," said the Secretary General and Director of Social Events, Dr María Alejandra Lipari.







#### **WELCOME RECEPTION:**

The congress was held at the Convention Center of Sheraton Santiago Hotel. Once the first day of the conference was over (Wednesday, October 4), the Opening Ceremony and a Welcome Cocktail begun, where attendees had a first approach to this important event.
