#### 1 ARTICLE I - NAME

<sup>3</sup> The international Association shall be known as "The International Association of

<sup>4</sup> Paediatric Dentistry" (IAPD), hereafter in this text, also as "the Association".

# 6 ARTICLE II - LEGAL HEADQUARTERS

7

The Association headquarters is located in Genève. The Association headquarters
can only be changed in accordance with the Constitution Article II.

The Biennial IAPD Congress should be held, whenever possible, on alternate
years. Special or additional scientific meetings may be held at the discretion of
the Board.

The country, in which the Biennial IAPD Congress is to be held, shall be decided
by the Board of Directors on the recommendations of the Congress Site
Selection and Coordination Committee, and subsequently ratified by the
Council.

The Biennial IAPD Congress shall not be held in the same country on
successive occasions and due consideration should be given to ensure an
equitable geographic distribution. The National-Member Society acting as host
shall abide by the IAPD Congress Guidelines.

4. The responsible National-Member Society is obliged to consult the Board of
Directors from time to time in matters relating to the organization, content, and
objectives of the Congress, and to adhere to all Board of Directors' requirements
as laid down in the IAPD Congress Guidelines.

46	3.	A nation can be represented by only one National Society or Section. If a nation
47	-	has more than one Paediatric Dental Society, it is necessary for those national
48		groups to decide which Society will be the National-Member Society of the
49		International Association of Paediatric Dentistry.

51	4.	A National-Member Society whose dues are two years in arrears must be
52		notified of this in writing by the Secretary General. If the National-Member
53		Society fails to meet their dues commitment, it shall be reported to the Board
54		and Council. Unless there is an unusual circumstance, the Secretary General
55		should recommend to Council that the National-Member Society shall cease to
56		be a member. Debts shall not be written off by the termination of membership.

58	b)	Individual Members
59		
60		Individual members must possess a recognised dental qualification in their
61		country of residence. Application may be done electronically through the IAPD
62		Website and/or IAPD secretariat. Only an individual member may hold a Board
63		or committee position or be a voting delegate to the Council or nominate a
64		member for election to the Board of Directors on behalf of a National-Member
65		Society.

#### 67 c) Honorary Members

68

An Honorary membership may be proposed by two National-Member Societies at least 6 months in advance of the Council Meeting. Alternatively, an Honorary member may be proposed by the Board and one National-Member Society. Honorary Membership is conferred by the Council on the recommendation of the Board of Directors, by two-thirds majority of those present and voting. An Honorary Member does not pay dues and is entitled to a 50% reduction in Congress Registration.

#### 77 d) Senior Members

78

Senior membership may be conferred to an individual member who is retired,
attained the age of 65 years and no longer working within private practice,
university, or hospital. Senior members are entitled to a 50% discount on their
annual membership subscriptions and a 50% discount on Congress
registrations. To obtain a senior membership, members must apply in writing to
the Secretariat.

## e) IAPD Supported Members

87

Membership in this category applies to those applying for IAPD individual membership from low-income nations. The list of nations eligible for IAPD support shall be determined annually and is based upon World Data Bank. IAPD supported members shall be entitled to a 50% reduction in annual membership subscriptions and a 50% discount on congress registrations. Supported Membership is confirmed by the Secretariat.

- 95 f) Postgraduate Student Members

Those in postgraduate university or hospital programs in paediatric dentistry are entitled to a 50% discount on biennial membership and a 50% discount on Congress registrations limited to two biennial congresses. To obtain a biennial student membership, a written application to the Secretariat is required. A letter
is also required from the applicant's program Director.

#### 102 f) Affiliate Members

103

Applications by organizations and Associations for Affiliate Membership shall be 104 made in writing to the IAPD secretariat. Such applications shall be accompanied 105 by the constitution of the organisation and documents attesting to the legal and 106 professional status of the organisation. The application shall be approved by 107 the Board and then be submitted to Council for ratification. Affiliate Members 108 shall be elected by approval of a two-thirds majority of those present and voting 109 at the Council. Affiliate Members' representatives may attend Council as 110 observers; however, they shall not be eligible to vote. 111

Membership for all the above categories except for honorary membership shall commence after payment of the first annual subscription following acceptance of the application.

## 117 ARTICLE V - COUNCIL AND COUNCIL MEETINGS

118

 The Council shall consist of one voting Delegate representing each National-Member Society. A National-Member Society may nominate an alternate delegate who only votes if the Delegate is absent. Only individual members in good standing may vote in Council.

Nominations for representatives and alternate representatives to the Council
should be made in writing by the National-Member Society and sent to the
Secretariat at least 60 days prior to the next Council Meeting and forwarded by
the Secretariat to all the Council Members 30 days before the Meeting.

3. The review of the activities of the Association shall be presented by the
Secretary General. The review shall be published for the general membership
of the Association in the Newsletter of the Association. The President may

- appoint an independent expert on parliamentarian procedures who shall serve
- at the discretion of the Council for the duration of that meeting.

4. The meeting shall proceed under common rules of accepted parliamentary
procedure.

# 138 ARTICLE VI. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

139

1. At least 6 months prior to a Congress, the Chair of the Nominations Committee 140 will contact Board members recommended by the President for an additional 141 term (exceptions are the President, Past President and President Elect) to 142 determine their interest in continuing the Board. Advertisement by way of the 143 Website, Journal, and letters to National-Member Societies should commence 144 following this determination and not later than 4 months prior to the Congress, 145 indicating the Board vacancies, application procedure and closing date for 146 nominations. 147

Nominations for membership of the Board of Directors may be made either by a
National Member Society and supported by a second National-Member Society
or may be proposed by the IAPD Board of Directors and supported by two
National-Member Societies. Every effort should be made to have the Board of
Directors represent different nations.

The submission of the nomination materials should be sent to IAPD Secretariat
at least 60 days before a Council Meeting and distributed to Secretary General,
President and Chair of the Nominations Committee.

4. Nominations for new Board members should be made on the Association's nomination form and should include the following information and be supported by the appropriate documentation. The candidate's name and the position for which the nomination is made. A 250-word summary of the candidate's curriculum vitae which outlines their professional background. A nominating form from a National-Member Society or from the Board of Directors should

include a statement that the person nominated has a sufficient knowledge of
and ability to communicate in English, to contribute effectively to the work of the
Board of Directors of IAPD. A seconding letter of endorsement from one other
National-Member Society. If the nomination is made by the IAPD Board of
Directors, two seconding National-Member Societies are required as noted in
VI.2. The candidate should be an IAPD individual member and showed interest
in IAPD activities.

5. Existing Board members eligible for re-election do not require re-nomination by
National-Member Societies. They require, however, a simple nomination by the
President of the Board. They must indicate in writing their willingness to serve
another term.

If there is no National-Member or Board nominations at the deadline, the
Nomination Committee may make a nomination, however, the nomination must
be supported by two National-Member Societies.

182 7. If there is more than one nomination for each position, the Nominations
183 Committee shall present a list of candidates in order of preference. The
184 Committee must present a written report at the Board meeting prior to the
185 Council meeting.

187 8. The Nominations Committee proposal shall be considered by the Board who
188 may modify the order of merit by a majority, closed ballot vote. The Board
189 President shall vote only in case of a tie.

192 9. The Board shall submit its final proposal to the Council for approval. The written
193 Nominations Committee report also may be presented.

194

10. The election of the Board of Directors shall be the final item of the agenda of the
Council Meeting coinciding with the Biennial Congress.

11. The Board of Directors' list of nominations should be submitted to the Council
Meeting to be approved by a simple majority.

12. The President shall conduct all the proceedings of the Association and shall
interpret the applications of the Constitution and By-laws. In the absence of the
President, the President's duty shall fall to the Immediate Past President, or if
unavailable, to a member of the Board of Directors chosen from among
themselves.

13. If a vacancy or vacancies occur with the term of Board members, the Board of
Directors shall decide on issues related to the management of the duties and
privileges associated with the vacancy of the position.

## 211 ARTICLE VII - BUDGETS AND ACCOUNTS

212

 Dues of National-Member Societies: The biennial dues to the Association shall be based on the total membership of the National Association in accordance with the number of members of each National-Member Society. Dues are calculated from 0-50 members, 51-100 members, or 101+ members. For IAPD supported nations, there is a basic flat fee as determined by the Board. IAPD Secretariat should be contacted for actual dues.

The above may be paid in Euros US Dollars or GB Pounds.

These dues may be determined and amended at the discretion of the Board and ratified by a simple majority vote at the next Council Meeting.

Dues of Individual, Senior, Post Graduate Students, IAPD Supported, and Affiliate Members shall be as determined by the Board and ratified by a simple majority vote at the next Council Meeting (see Art. IV - b to f). Honorary Members do not pay dues.

229 2. Dues shall be payable within 30 days of the expiration date, after which all
230 member privileges and benefits will be suspended.

232	3.	The Membership Committee shall identify the countries that shall be entitled to
233		the IAPD Supported membership on annual basis. The Secretariat shall inform
234		those nations eligible for IAPD Supported membership upon application and/or
235		membership renewal date.
236		
237	4.	The scientific journal is provided gratis to Honorary members and is included in
238		the Membership fee for Individual and Senior members. Each National-Member
239		Society shall receive a journal copy which is part of their membership fees.

241	5.	All bank accounts require 2 signatures. These will be the Secretary General,
242		President, or Past President.

246	1.	In all administrative matters the text is given in English.
247		
248	2.	In Council Meetings the spoken language is English. Each National-Member
249		Society has a responsibility to procure the necessary translations
